Do you want to learn about medical careers and help others in your community?

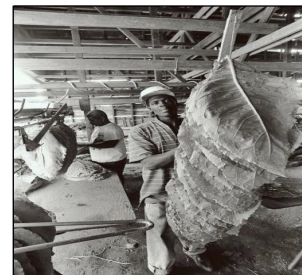
If yes, take part in a **UConn Migrant Farm Worker Health Clinic!**
